

# PawsPay - Installation guide

Multi-currency WooCommerce plugin



Follow the steps bellow to install the plugin in your Woocommerce store and start accepting cryptocurrency payments supported by the plugin.

## 1 Download plugin

Download the plugin from the official PAWS Coin website, over the following link:

## 2 Install plugin

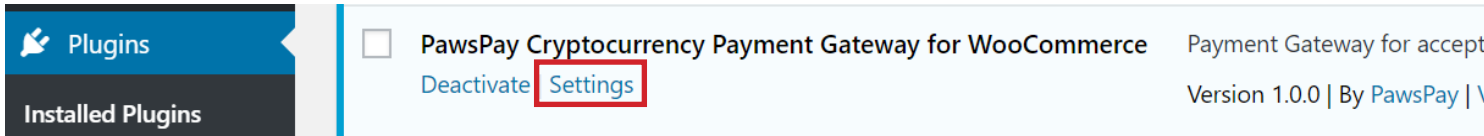
To install the plugin, navigate to [Plugins/Add New](#) in the main navigation. After that, press “Upload plugin” and choose file “woocommerce-pawspay.zip” in the upload form. Press “Install Now”.

Once the plugin is installed successfully, press the button “Activate Pugin”.

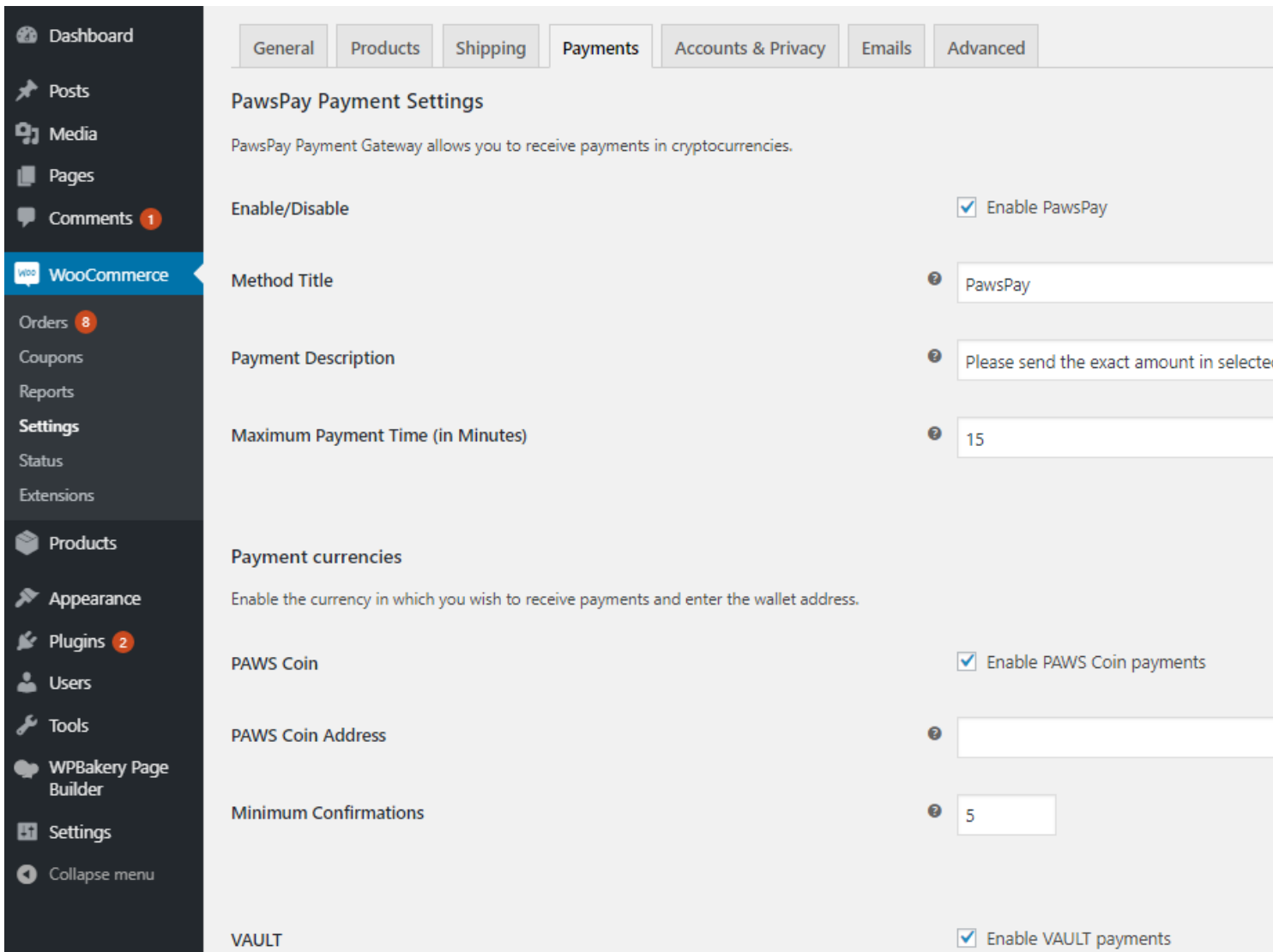
# 3 Configure settings

Before you start accepting payments, you need to enable the desired currency and add the payment address. In the list of plugins, click on “Settings” link.



On settings page, all settings are predefined with optimal configuration, however, you can change them according to your preferences.

Enable your desired payment currency, add the currency address in required field, and save settings. Make sure that you only use this address for receiving payments on your e-commerce store.



That's all! You are ready now to start receiving payments in your selected cryptocurrencies!
